

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TELEPHONE
RATES IN THE VILLAGE OF BETHEL; AND
PRESCRIBING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BETHEL,

ALASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Schedule.

The monthly, or as otherwise specified, rates for telephone equipment and service supplied by the Telephone Company shall be in accordance with the following schedule. The service area of the Village of Bethel shall be that area actually served by the telephone company in and around the immediate boundaries of the Village of Bethel.

Section 2. Availability.

This schedule is available throughout the service area for all business telephone service with the standard instrument, to the extent that the company has available sufficient capacity and equipment.

Ten Party	5.75 (Rural)

Joint User	10.00 One-half the primary rate
Extension, with <u>inside</u>	2.00
Extension, with <u>outside</u>	3.50

Section 3. Availability For Residential Telephones.

This schedule is available throughout the service area for all residential telephone service with the standard instrument, to the extent that the company has available sufficient capacity and equipment.

route measurement 5.50
Cable Pair rental, mile and over
1/4 mile or fraction thereof,
entire route measurement 1.50

PBX, Inter-Office, or Inter-
Exchange Trunk (other than city
owned terminal facilities) 50.00

One way incoming trunk from ad-
jacent military establishments to
the City 85.00

Also, a deposit of \$35.00 may be required
for use of the telephone company.

Section 5. Rules and Regulations.

The Council is hereby issued authority to promulgate such rules and regulations as it may deem appropriate for the implementation of this Ordinance, which rules and regulations shall be filed with the City Clerk.

Section 6. Penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance on conviction shall be fined not more than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00), or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both, at the discretion of the court.

Section 7. Validity of Ordinance.

If any section, sub-section, sub-division, sentence, clause or phrase

of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or void such invalidity shall not thereby affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 8. Effective Date.

This ordinance is to take effect and be in full force after the 1st

day of March, 1959.
