

RESOLUTION 461

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING A PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY
BY THE GOVERNOR OF ALASKA.

WHEREAS, in May of 1985, the City of Bethel and its residents
sustained losses and threats to life and property re-
sulting from flooding of the Kuskokwim River; and

WHEREAS, Bethel is a Second Class City in the State of Alaska;
and

WHEREAS, as a result of this disaster, the City owned petroleum
off-loading dock, which serves Bethel and surrounding
villages, sustained damage, and four homes have become
unsafe due to flood caused loss of bank; and

WHEREAS, the severity and magnitude of the emergency is beyond
the timely and effective response capability of local
resources,

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City of Bethel declare a
Disaster Emergency to exist in Bethel.

FURTHERMORE, it is requested that the Governor declare a Disaster
Emergency to exist as provided for in AS 26.23 and provide such
assistance as is requested and/or request additional assistance
from the President or appropriate federal agencies where State
capability is not adequate. Attached is a statement describing
the assistance required and the extent of local commitment.


FURTHERMORE, the undersigned certifies that the City of Bethel

\$ 90,000.00.

ATTACHMENT TO CITY OF BETHEL RESOLUTION
OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

ASSISTANCE REQUESTED

Funds to relocate four homes rendered unsafe due to loss of riverbank, excluding any eventual costs for purchase of property. Estimated maximum cost \$ 100,000.00 .

Funds to repair petroleum off-loading dock, estimated maximum cost of \$ 85,000.00 .

Funds to replace lost fill at end of present seawall, \$10,000.00 .

LOCAL GOVERNMENT CONTRIBUTION TO RECOVERY FROM DISASTER EMERGENCY

Possible purchase of residential lots for relocated homes -
\$ 80,000.00 .

Site preparation at petroleum off-loading dock - \$10,000.00.
