A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING THE BIDS SUBMITTED FOR THE EXPANSION AND REMODELING OF THE BUILDING OWNED BY THE CITY OF BETHEL AND OCCUPIED BY THE STATE OF ALASKA COURTS, DISTRICT ATTORNEYS, STATE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE AND OTHERS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE THE APPROPRIATE NOTICES UPON COMPLETION OF NECESSARY REVIEWS

WHEREAS the City of Bethel is the owner of the building which currently houses the State of Alaska courts, District Attorney's offices, State's Attorneys and others; and

WHEREAS the Alaska Office of the Courts has approached the City of Bethel, proposing expanding the size of the building; and

WHEREAS the City of Bethel has requested public bids to perform the work necessary to expand the building currently used by the Alaska Court system; and

WHEREAS the City of Bethel has received and opened bids for the proposed expansion of the building currently used by the Alaska Court system;


WHEREAS the City of Bethel must review each bid for completeness, feasibility, and appropriateness.
