GRANT APPLICATION TO BETHEL COMMUNITY SERVICES FOUNDATION TO REQUEST BETHEL TRANSIT SYSTEM VEHICLE MATCHING FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel and Orutsararmiut Native Council are working together with other Bethel agencies to develop, operate, and maintain a public transit system in Bethel, Alaska;

WHEREAS, the City received a grant in the amount of \$120,000 from the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to purchase two 14-passenger buses for use in the public transit system;


WHEREAS, the two buses were ordered and delivered to Bethel by barge on August 10, 2008 at a total purchase price of \$161,060 (\$80,530 each);

WHEREAS, after applying the City's grant, there remains a need for \$41,060 in cash match;

WHEREAS, Bethel Community Services Foundation has expressed an interest in assisting the transit system by providing the cash match necessary for the purchase of the two vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council supports the preparation and submission of a grant application to the Bethel Community Services Foundation, Inc. to request \$41,060 to reimburse the City for the cash match the City made to purchase the two transit vehicles;
