RESOLUTION NO. 274

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO PLAN AND DESIGN A SWIMMING POOL UTILIZING A WASTE HEAT RECOVERY SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bethel, recognizes the need to provide recreation to the Bethel community through the construction of a municipal swimming pool; and

WHEREAS, the Calista Corporation has agreed to provide a long term lease for five (5) acres of land adjacent to Bethel Utilities; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Bethel, with the active support of Bethel Utilities, to construct a municipal pool using a waste heat recovery system, and

WHEREAS, the City Council requests the Department of Energy to re-lease \$70,000 of waste heat recovery monies for the purpose of preliminary architectural and engineering designs;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council intends to construct a municipal pool using a waste heat recovery system;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council requests grant funds from the Department of Energy for the aforementioned project and authorizes City Administration to administer such funds as appropriated.
