

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING MAXIMUM PENALTIES
PRESCRIBED IN CERTAIN ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AND SETTING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA:

WHEREAS, several of the early ordinances of the City of Bethel provide maximum fines in the sum of \$100.00 or penalties up to thirty days in jail, or both, and

WHEREAS, the Village Incorporation Act of 1957, as amended, sets the maximum penalty of a \$25.00 fine or 5 days imprisonment or both, therefore

SECTION 1. In all ordinances of the City of Bethel, the maximum penalties shall be, and are, a fine not to exceed \$25.00 or five days imprisonment, or both, such fine and imprisonment, notwithstanding a greater maximum penalty being incorporated in any other ordinance heretofore adopted.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval.
