WHEREAS, the City of Bethel wishes to promote the orderly and efficient development and placement of utilities; and


WHEREAS, the BMC 17.04.070 B. requires the placement of utility facilities in a dedicated street, right-of-way or easement may occur only by permit issued by the city and subject to a one time or annual fee established by council by resolution; and


WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that an application for a utility permit under BMC 17.04.070 B. be assessed a one time non refundable \$400.00 application fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska establishes the amount of \$400.00 as the one time non refundable application fee for all permit applications received pursuant to BMC 17.04.070 B.
