RESOLUTION #427

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA TO GRANT TO THE CITY OF BETHEL FUNDS FOR THE PLANNING, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, IMPROVEMENT AND EXPANSION OF NEW AND EXISTING ROADS IN BETHEL AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO CARRY OUT ALL NECESSARY FUNCTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT.

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements and expansion of the Bethel road system will promote a safer road system in Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel's Public Works Department is prepared to build, gravel and generally improve new and existing roads in Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has appropriated \$550,000 in Municipal Grant Funds to the City of Bethel for such road improvements,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska that the City Administration is directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain a State Grant for funding the design and construction of new and improved roads in Bethel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's representative in accepting and implementing the grant award.
