RESOLUTION #323

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL REQUESTING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA (DOTPF) TO PLAT AND CONSTRUCT A ROAD FROM BETHEL TO NAPAKIAK AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS COUNCIL'S REPRESENTATIVE IN ACCEPTANCE AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS GRANT AWARD.

WHEREAS, the State Legislature in 1979, through FCCSSB 53, has approved a municipal grant to the City of Bethel in the amount of \$250,000, for construction of the Bethel-Napakiak road; and,

WHEREAS, the State Legislature, through HB60, has approved a municipal grant in the amount of \$600,000, for the Bethel-Napakiak road; and,


WHEREAS, there exists a need and desire by residents of both communitites to connect the communitites by a road.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, hereby requests the aforementioned municipal grant funds totaling \$850,000, from the State of Alaska for platting, surveying, right of way, purchase a lease and construction of the Bethel-Napakiak road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager or his designee is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's authorized representative to accept and implement this grant award.
