## MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING - JANUARY 9, 1960 - N. C. THEATRE

Meeting opened at 8.30.

Present were Gamble, Shantz, Hall, Jackson, Smit, Elliott

No minutes of previous meeting were available.

After communications, Council requested further information on status of filing on former airstrip for public use. Also reiteration of need for Municipal Reserve in each new town-site addition.

A letter is to be written to Leonard Lowell asking for copy of alleged easement across Main Street.

Report of Committee of the Whole is read. As a result of its recommendations, Mayor reappoints Police Committee; Chairman Gamble, Members Hall, Schatt-sneider. Mr. Gamble to procure two more members.

Resolution was passed approving First National Bank Checks to be signed by Mayor Jackson, Ray Miller and Lillie Schmidt, two signature out of three being required. Mninanimous.

Final Reading Ordinance # ~~12~~ on Fines. Shantz moves passage, Gamble seconds, All ayes no naves.

Final reading Ordinance # 12 on Sales Taxes. Amendment was adopted that the second paragraph of Section 15 read as follows:

"The tax is further extended to the service of rentals, with the provision that this extension is does not imply that rentals ~~did not fall under the sales tax ordinance provisions~~ were previously exempt."

Smit moves for adoption of amendment, Gamble seconds. All ayes no naves.

Shantz moves that Ordinance be passed as Ordinance # 12. Elliott seconds. All ayes none opposed.

Smite moves that meeting be extended until 10.30. Shantz seconds. All ayes, none opposed.

Legislative requests for amendments to Village Incorporation Act and for various other purposes are proposed by the Mayor. Smit moves that the amendments and other items be approved as desirable by the Council and be circulated to members of the Legislature. Shantz seconds. All ayes none opposed.

Smit moves that names of to individuals who are interested in civil defense be submitted to the Director of Civil Defense in Juneau for his selection in filling local Civil Defense Vacancy. Elliott Seconds. All ayes none opposed.
