WHEREAS, Thomas "Pinky" Sekenoff dedicated a great deal of his time and energy in providing recreation areas for the children of Bethel; and,


WHEREAS, Thomas "Pinky" Sekenoff was loved and respected by all those who knew him; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to allow for the memory of Thomas "Pinky" Sekenoff in continue to live within this community.


