**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE USE OF CITY OWNED PROPERTY FOR  
A FAMILY AND COMMUNITY RECREATION FACILITY**

**Whereas,** The Parks and Recreation committee supports the use of City owned property for family and community recreation locations, and;

**Whereas,** A preferred site for a community and visitor park would be on Bethel's waterfront, and;

**Whereas,** The Parks and Recreation committee recognizes the need for a river entrance and green space to welcome visitors and allow Bethel residents to enjoy the waterfront property for their recreational needs, and;


**Whereas,** The original seawall plan included community green space, and;

**Whereas,** The waterfront property identified by the Parks and Recreation committee is the last city-owned waterfront land available, and;

**Whereas,** It is necessary to research the feasibility of the identified waterfront property for the seawall park and campground.


