A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, SUBMITTING THE CITY OF BETHEL'S TRANSPORTATION PROJECT PRIORITIES TO THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is committed to achieving the best possible road system to serve the residents and visitors of the City; and

WHEREAS, adequate transportation facilities are essential for residents' quality of life, expanding commerce, developing resources, and a healthier environment; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, in compliance with the Federal Highway funding in the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA), seeks to serve the needs of local communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel seeks to develop and improve its basic infrastructure in an effort to support economic development within the community; and

WHEREAS, the local roads are identified and prioritized by the City according to need

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council hereby submits the following projects for inclusion in the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities' Transportation Needs and Priorities List for the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP):

1. Brown Slough Bridge Replacement
2. Ridgecrest Drive Reconstruction
3. Fourth Avenue Loop Improvement
4. Akakeek Street Improvement
5. Ptarmigan Street Improvement
6. Tundra Ridge Road Improvement
7. Seventh Avenue Improvement
8. East Avenue Improvement
9. Main Street Improvement
10. Boardwalk Construction/Rehabilitation
11. Sewage Lagoon Road Improvement


