

Minutes of the Bethel Village Council Jan. 21, 1959 N.C Theater.

Carpenter opened meeting at 8 P.m.

Council members present All Others 150?

Purpose of meeting discussion from the floor for or against the sale of intoxicating liquor in Bethel. Carpenter gave instructions on voting.

Time Sat. 24th from 8 A.M to 8 P.M. at the Cowan hut. 21 years of age,

resident of Bethel 30 days, Territory of Alaska 1 year. Secret Ballot vote.

Councils recommendation will be the majority vote of the residents of Bethel, to the Alaska Liquor Board. Absentee ballots to be left with U.S. Comm.

Chance asked minutes of previous meeting read and asked purpose of this meeting. Minutes read. Carpenter stated purpose of having meeting so

there would be a full representation of townspeople for open discussion on sale of liquor in Bethel.

Elliot moved all contents of incoming letters be known to all council members before reading in public. N. Guinn seconded. 5 ayes 0 nays Motion passed.

Discussion from the floor recorded on tape.

Elliot moved meeting be ajourned. Guinn seconded 5 ayes 0 nays
