#### **A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE OCTOBER 3, 2000 REGULAR CITY ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the Canvas Board of the City of Bethel met on October 9, 2000 and tallied the votes of Questioned and Absentee ballots and the ballots cast by voters and counted on election night; and

WHEREAS, the precinct tallies as recorded by the Canvas Board are as follows:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL:**

**SECTION 1.** That Jerry Drake was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.


**SECTION 2.** That Carl Berger was elected to a 3-year term, having received the second greatest number of votes cast.

**SECTION 3.** That the Advisory Question, whether the Bethel City Council should enact an Ordinance establishing an Alcohol Delivery Site, was answered in the negative, in that a greater number of votes cast were against an Alcohol Delivery Site.

**SECTION 4.** That Ordinance #00-18, increasing the sales and use tax from 5 percent to 6 percent, shall not be enacted, in that a greater number of votes cast opposed the proposition to increase the sales and use tax.
