**RESOLUTION #02-13**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING FY02 SAFE COMMUNITIES FUNDING FROM  
THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

**WHEREAS**, AS 29.60.350(b) requires the governing body of a municipality to adopt a resolution requesting safe communities funding and to submit the resolution to the Department of Community and Economic Development, Division of Community and Business Development; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel desires to receive safe communities funding; and

**WHEREAS**, AS 29.60.350(c) requires that money received by a municipality under the safe communities program be used only for the following services in the following ranking priority:

- 1) Police protection and related public safety services,
- 2) Fire protection and emergency medical services,
- 3) Water and sewer services not offset by user fees,
- 4) Solid waste management, and
- 5) Other services determined by the governing body to have the highest priority, and;


**WHEREAS**, the FY03 Safe Communities Program payment date is July 31, 2002.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, by this Resolution hereby requests payment from the Safe Communities program by the Department of Community and Economic Development and agrees to spend such payment as required by law.
