

A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL TO ACCEPT THE FY 2005 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT AWARDS TOTALING \$365,000

- WHEREAS**, the City's Grant Development Manager facilitated input from the Administration, Fire, Police, and Public Works departments, the Alaska Division of Public Health, Yukon-Kuskowkwim Health Corporation, United Utilities, Inc., and radio stations KYUK and KYKD to prepare and submit an FY 2005 Homeland Security Grant application;
- WHEREAS**, the State of Alaska, Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management approved the City of Bethel to receive \$274,000 under the State Homeland Security Program and \$91,000 under the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program;
- WHEREAS**, both grant awards to the City of Bethel require no cash or in-kind match and have a performance period of March 28, 2005 through March 31, 2007;
- WHEREAS** funding from the FY 2005 Homeland Security grant will significantly enhance the ability of the Bethel Police and Fire Departments to prevent, deter, and respond to emergencies by providing money for new equipment, including a 250 Kilowatt back-up generator with automatic switching to provide auxiliary power to essential City buildings and the KYUK radio station;
- WHEREAS** funding from the FY 2005 Homeland Security grant will provide the KYKD radio station with its own back-up generator with automatic switching;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Bethel City Council accepts the FY2005 Homeland Security Grant awards totaling \$365,000 and pledges to fulfill its responsibility in the administration of the awards.
