

RESOLUTION #721

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, TO INVESTIGATE THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING AN ASBESTOS REPOSITORY WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL.

WHEREAS, there is a need by the City of Bethel for economic development by obtaining outside financial resources; and

WHEREAS, the Public Health Service, under contract, has an obligation to restore to a pristine condition several sites within the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, these sites are known to be contaminated with the airborne contaminant, asbestos; and

WHEREAS, the Public Health Service seeks to identify a repository for this contaminant; and

WHEREAS, the Public Health Service has monies to develop a repository and to pay for legal disposal of said contaminant, and that these monies could economically benefit the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, these contaminants, as required by law, would upon receipt be packaged so as to be in a harmless state; and


WHEREAS, the sole responsibility of the City of Bethel would be the transporting and burial of the containers, delivered to the City by agents for the Public Health Service or the Corps of Engineers; and

WHEREAS, the only permit the City of Bethel would be applying for, and responsible to, would be for the landfilling of asbestos.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council approves the investigation and evaluation of the feasibility of establishing an asbestos repository site within the jurisdiction of the City of Bethel.
