

MINUTES OF SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 21, 1963

At the National Guard Armory
8:00 P.M.

Present: Swanson, Hoffman, Sallison, Baker and Mendola

Financial reports from four fiscal years on Revenues and Expenditures were compared and from these figures a proposed budget for the fiscal year 1964 was set forth.

MMS/Hoffman, Mendola that the budget be accepted as presented. Hoffman, Sallison, Baker and Mendola in favor.

Businesses failing to send in sales tax money to the city were discussed. Pensgard Enterprises in the amount of \$616.11, Tundra Shack - \$185.41 and Tundra Telephone - \$359.91. Joe Mendola was chosen to speak to Pensgard about the matter and the mayor stated he would talk to Max Lieb. Further reports are to be given at the next regular council meeting.

MMS/Hoffman, Mendola that a registered letter be sent to Ditto of Tundra Telephone requesting payment of sales tax. MC.

Diagrams, charts and material for sanitation truck purposes were presented by Ben Wilkens. These items are to be presented at the next regular council meeting and are to be compared with the material and ideas that Earth Moving has for the possibility of a sanitation truck.

MMS/Hoffman, Mendola that the Northern Commercial bill against the sanitation service be paid by the city. Hoffman, Sallison, Baker and Mendola in favor.

City Clerk to call Tundra Telephone, Earth Movers and the Bank to find out the amount of money owed to each one by Baker's Sanitation Service.

MMS/Hoffman, Baker that Ben Wilkens be appointed the 12th member on the Liquor Petition Review Committee in place of Max Fancher who declined the position. MC.
