
RESOLUTION #01-03

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING FORCE ACCOUNT REHABILITATION OF THE SAINT MARY'S AIRPORT ROAD

- WHEREAS,** The community of Saint Mary's is served by the Saint Mary's Airport; and
- WHEREAS,** The City of Saint Mary's is six miles away from the Saint Mary's Airport; and
- WHEREAS,** The road to Saint Mary's Airport is in need of rehabilitation; and
- WHEREAS,** The community of Saint Mary's, represented by the City of Saint Mary's has proposed to the State of Alaska that the Force Account method of project management be utilized in rehabilitation of the Airport Road; and
- WHEREAS,** The City of Bethel has conducted Force Account projects and is aware of the practicality, utility, efficiency and economy of the Force Account method of project management; and
- WHEREAS,** Force Account management of major projects including Village Safe Water and sanitary facilities construction, Local Service Roads and Trails, airport construction, community facilities construction, upgrade and repair and many other examples have been successful, and have net positive impacts on both the State of Alaska and the local communities, their residents and economics;
