REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING AUGUST 13, 1975

7:30 P.M.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Hoffman at 7:35 P.M.
Present: Andrew, Peltola, Crow, Murphy, Nicori, Hall.

Minutes of July 23, 1975 were read by Campbell.
M/M Peltola that the minutes of July 23, 1975 be approved with corrections made.
Voice vote, unanimous in favor. Motion passed.

COMMUNICATIONS

There were four attachments to the Council packets and are attached as a part of these minutes.

MANAGERS REPORT

Managers report was given verbally by Campbell.
The city is still in search of barrels, also we busted beer cans which no one would buy. The 12 by 24 walk-in freezer is now operable.

Hall- I understand that the city is going to start charging out at the Dump.

Item C. Greater Bethel Council on Alcoholism

M/M Crow that the City Council be temporary Bethel Council Alcohol acting Board until Council can appoint new members.

Roll call Vote, Yes, Peltola, Hoffman, Murphy, Nicori, Hall, Crow. No, Andrew. Motion passed.

M/M Peltola that Mike Jones be put on agenda under New Business, Item E.

Voice vote, unanimous in favor. Motion passed,
