


RESOLUTION #630

- WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is a second class City which has a local Police Department with 21 employees; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has banned the sale of liquor since 11-1-77, and the governing body of the City concur that the alcohol problem is a major issue in the community; and
- WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Bethel agree to support the State Alcohol Rewards and Enforcement (ARE) program, and authorize submission of the application for the first ARE grant in an amount of \$10,000.00; and
- WHEREAS, the Governing body of the City of Bethel hereby appoint Lieutenant Chris Liu of the Bethel Police Department as the Project Administrator of the ARE Program under the supervision of Chief of Police Kevin Clayton; and
- WHEREAS, the Governing body of the City of Bethel further agree to support the Project Administrator in meeting the requirements of the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council by and through the Bethel Police Department hereby request the ARE Program fund initially in an amount of \$10,000.00.
