WHEREAS, the Bethel Police Department intends to use the mobile command trailer when responding to major crimes that warrant its use;

WHEREAS, the trailer is in the process of purchasing much-needed forensic equipment and supplies and needs a vehicle for storage and deployment of its forensic investigative resources;


WHEREAS, the Police Department's mobile 911 communications console inside the mobile command center trailer can serve as a mobile emergency 911 communication center, if needed;
