RESOLUTION #98-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, DECLARING 26 BICYCLES AS SURPLUS, AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS BICYCLES TO A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION AND DECLARING APRIL 25 AS BETHEL BIKE SAFETY DAY.

WHEREAS, many children are hurt every year in bicycle accidents and bicycle safety education may have prevented injury; and

WHEREAS, the city of Bethel is without a designated bike path; and

WHEREAS, the Bethel PTA and YKHC Injury Prevention and other members of the community are dedicated to the physical welfare of the children of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the Bethel PTA, YKHC Injury Prevention, City of Bethel and Bethel Youth Center are sponsoring a bike rodeo at the National Guard Armory on April 25 and require additional bicycles for the purpose of education, donating, and raising funds; and


WHEREAS, the Bethel Police Department is in possession of a number of abandoned or confiscated bicycles in various stages of repair, and the bicycles have not been claimed by the owners within the designated time; and


WHEREAS, the Bethel Municipal Code 4.10.030C allows for the sale, trade or exchange of surplus or obsolete supplies, materials and equipment following adoption of a City Council resolution declaring the supplies, materials or equipment obsolete and/or surplus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, Declares 26 Bicycles as Surplus, Authorizes the Disposal of Said Surplus to a Non-Profit Organization and Declares April 25 as Bethel Bike Safety Day.

PASSED AND APPROVED THIS 14TH DAY OF APRIL 1998, by a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining.
