

RESOLUTION #367

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA TO REPAIR THE BETHEL AIRPORT TO ALLOW FOR SAFE TRAVEL TO AND FROM BETHEL.

WHEREAS, Bethel is the transportation center for the 56 villages of the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta; and,

WHEREAS, the bumps at the south end of the runway has caused State of Alaska to cut off the use of the southern 1500' of the runway causing potentially hazardous conditions for large aircrafts operating in and out of Bethel; and,


WHEREAS, the commercial airlines serving Bethel are now cancelling flights due to hazardous runway conditions; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska owns and operates the Bethel Airport thus making the maintenance of the airport and the insurance of safe flying conditions both the State's responsibility.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Bethel herein requests that the State of Alaska take whatever immediate action is necessary to solve the hazardous problems of the runway to once again insure for safe and dependable flying conditions for all citizens of the Bethel area.
