

November 7 meeting 1966

The meeting was called to order at 8 :00 by Ben Smit. Ray Miller was elected temporary president. Roll was called--Gable, Elliott, Shantz, Miller, Smit were present. Hall and Jackson were absent. Minutes were read by Lillian Jung--no corrections--minutes were accepted.

Communications were read.

A motion was made we hire a lawyer to collect the delinquent sales taxes from Northern Continental Inc. seconded by Elliott--all ayes none opposed. *Insurance Co.*

Shantz moved the sec. (Smit) write to Trans. Alaska Communications to submit a proposed contract. Gable seconded all ayes none opposed.

Shantz moved we write to the Boundry Commission and oppose Boroughs until the public is more informed. all ayes--none opposed. Gable seconded.

The council will have a special meeting on Monday-Nov. 21 for budget purposes. The chairman call an adjournment for 10 minutes.

A motion was made by Elliott that we write to the insurance co. and explain about Walton's plane and file a claim. Shantz seconded--all ayes none opposed.

Gamble suggested we contact Sarge and prevent carrying away private property as trash.

Shantz moved we appropriate an additional \$318.00 for the garbage sanitation truck for a total of \$1573.00. Miller seconded. all ayes none opposed.

Gamble proposed Sarge and crew continue cleaning up garbage until temperature make outside work impossible.

Elliott suggested we put 15 new street lights in the city. Cost last year was \$1100.00 approx. \$75.00 apiece.

A motion was made by Smit that the police officer contact the N C. C. for any burned out street lights for which a service charge of \$1.00 and an additional 35¢ for the bulb will be charged. Seconded by Miller, all ayes none opposed.

Elliott made a motion we buy 15 new street lights to be placed at the following places: Alaska Airlines, Army Advisors, Judy Westdahl, half way between Ray Chris's and airport, Pinky's, Ludwigsen, Fannie Jim, Carl Kawagley, Adolph Lind, Smeaton's, Sis Troseth, Gambles, Jim Kohl by new school, ADH-ACS, across from N C boardwalk, 3 lights from Carl Romer's toward Art Dull's, and Jack Smith's. Smit seconded--member were polled. all ayes none opposed.

Shantz moved we adjourn, Smit seconded.
