A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING GOVERNOR SHEFFIELD TO RE-ESTABLISH AN OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR IN BETHEL, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, at the present time there exist Offices of the Governor in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Kotzebue, and Nome: and

WHEREAS, Bethel is the Transportation and Communication Center for some 57 villages covering over 90,000 square miles: and

WHEREAS, it is very hard to communicate Southwestern Alaska's needs to the existing Offices of the Governor,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that the City Administration request Governor Sheffield to re-establish an office of the Governor in Bethel, Alaska to serve the citizens of Southwestern Alaska.
