

Minutes of the Bethel Village Council
N.C Theater, 8PM, July 6th, 1959

Meeting called to order by President Robert Carpenter at 8PM.
Roll call, : Present Carpenter, Elliot, Smit, Christianson, Romer,
Guinn. Sallison Absent.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. Special Meeting minutes read and approved.

Carpenter advised water unit did not get on barge from Anchorage and at present no way of bringing unit to Bethel, so unit order was cancelled. Thomas Haley resigned as Village Policeman. Darrel Conick appointed as new policeofficer for the Village of Bethel. Memo from McRoberts read. Smit made Finance report. Bank balance ledger in order. Smit reported Dick Jones audited books, as yet no report from Jones. , also suggested we ask Dept. of taxation to give ~~copy~~ Council full report on Business Houses.

Treasurers report as of June 30th 14,809.60

Report from Smit on Street lights. One phot electric cell on way for sample. Street lights will be in by the time the last Boat from States arrives.

Weise explained Senate Bill #26 article by article. Suggested ~~Council~~ Council write McRoberts to attempt to make some arrangement on use of Federal Jail, renting jail for Village prisnors, once Home Rule adopted it will be necessary to have ~~place~~ place for prisnors.

Mr Nickolson presented proposal on well, complete estimate \$32,845 for building fixtures plus \$8,450 for rehabilitation of well, completing well, furnishing pump. Total 41,295. Estimated time in completing job 1/4 working days, 10 hour a day. Open discussion from floor.

Council feels cost on well reasonable, but ~~price~~ price on well does not include access road or sanding. Carpenter states we had better by-pass building. Feels we can ~~pay~~ at the present time, pay up to 10,000 dollars, but not any more. All in agreement.

Elliot to contact Mr Featherstone Area Plant Manager, Bureau of Indian Affairs, asking him to draw up plans and price estimate on 20x20 building chloranator, 6,000raw, 2500 treated- 10,000 gallons capacity.

Write letter to the State Board of Education asking permission for Village to use school well, until such a time the Village can develop own well.

Write Bureau of Indian Affairs for permit on groundwell is on.

Nora Guinn suggested Village buy car for use of Policeofficer, Policeman ~~who~~ should have some form of identification, Police officer must comply with requirements stated by Chief US Deputy McRoberts in memorandum read earlier, Police officer should have one day off a week, one day toward vacation time a month. Also suggested Pierson keep a complete log on arrests complaints signed by him, disposition of prisnors and present the total of each at regular Council Meetings, excluding names of prisnors. Agreed. Smit moved Policeman have one day off a week, providing he does not tell anyone but Deputy Pierson which day, taking it at his own discretion, and one day vacation accumulation time a month. Christianson seconded. 6 ayes, 0 nays.

Deputy Chuck Pierson explained Complaints must be signed also prisnor must be advised to why he was arrested.

Elliot to look into any possibility of buying a car for use of Village Police.

Elliot moved meeting be adjourned. Christianson seconded.
