A RESOLUTION APPROVING ELECTRIC POWER SYSTEMS, INC. AS THE CONTRACTOR TO CONDUCT A PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING STUDY FOR A PROGRESSIVE WIND POWER SYSTEM IN BETHEL

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel received an SFY 2006 legislative grant in the amount of \$150,000 for a wind power feasibility study;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel issued a Request for Proposals over a 30-day period ending November 15, 2006 for preliminary engineering required to develop a low-to-high penetration wind power system;


WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Electric Power Systems, Inc. in response to the RFP was scored by a review committee composed of Alternative Energy Committee members and recommended for funding;

WHEREAS, Electric Power Systems, Inc. plans to conduct the study from January to May 2007 at a cost of \$150,000;

WHEREAS, no cash or in-kind match is required from the City in the administration of this legislative grant;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council approves Electric Power Systems, Inc. as the contractor to conduct a preliminary engineering study for a progressive wind power system in Bethel, Alaska.
