RESOLUTION # 321

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THAT THE \$2,000,000.00 BOND BE SPENT ON A RECREATION FACILITY WITHIN THE CITY OF BETHEL.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel, Alaska is engaged in operating a City Parks and Recreation Department providing the public with recreation facilities and programs, and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department is currently working out of severely limited and antiquated space which limits the type and scope of programs available to the public, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is currently pursuing the construction of a City owned and run recreational facility, and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska authorized a \$2,000,000.00 bond to the Lower Kuskokwim School District for construction of a swimming pool to be located in Bethel, Alaska, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is interested in combining the recreation facilities available to the public in the City of Bethel, and

WHEREAS, the construction of a swimming pool may be desirable depending on the operational costs.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Bethel, hereby supports the issue of said \$2,000,000.00 bond, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Bethel wants to insure that the \$2,000,000.00 bond is spent on a recreation facility within the City of Bethel, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the \$2,000,000.00 bond be made available to combine with the City funds designated for construction of a recreation facility so that a facility may in fact be built in 1981 construction season.
