ORDINANCE #99-23

A ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ADOPTED ANNUAL FY 1999-2000 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING \$15,000 FOR THE DOWN PAYMENT OF A BOILER FOR THE LAUNDROMAT

WHEREAS, Emergency Ordinance #99-20 was enacted by the City Council on September 1, 1999; and

WHEREAS, emergency ordinances are only valid for sixty days;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is not of a general nature and shall not be codified.




SECTION 3. The Promissory Note will be recorded as a receivable to recover the loan.
