

RESOLUTION #265

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES TO GRANT THE CITY OF BETHEL THE NECESSARY FUNDS TO MAINTAIN EXISTING GRAVEL ROADS AND GRAVEL KWETHLUK LANE.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature has appropriated \$100,000 for graveling streets in Bethel, and;

WHEREAS, many gravel roads are in need of repair which requires graveling, and;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have year round access to Bethel's power plant being serviced by Kwethluk Lane; and;

WHEREAS, the present road is constructed with sand which is impossible to travel across at least one or two weeks out of each year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT Resolved that the City of Bethel requests \$100,000 grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for maintaining existing gravel roads in Bethel and graveling Kwethluk Lane.

AND BE IT FURTHER Resolved that the City Manager or his designee be directed to implement the above program if funded.
