Ordinance #09-45

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A "TAX FREE DAY" TO BE HELD ANNUALLY ON BLACK FRIDAY ON WHICH SALES, RENTALS, AND SERVICES WILL BE EXEMPT FROM CITY SALES TAX

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. Adding Chapter 4.16.330 Tax free day is hereby enacted to read as follows:

4.16.330 Tax free day.

(a) All sales, for goods made on the Friday following Thanksgiving of each year, and that otherwise would be subject to the tax imposed by this chapter, are exempt from that tax at the option of the seller.

(b) The seller shall report all sales for goods that are exempt from tax under this section as exempt sales on its sales tax return

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
