A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA REQUESTING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA FOR THE BETHEL FAMILY CLINIC.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature has appropriated \$75,000 for the purchase of medical equipment by the Bethel Family Clinic; and


WHEREAS, the Bethel Family Clinic is a major provider of health services to residents of the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of additional medical equipment by the Bethel Family Clinic will better enable the Clinic to provide medical services for the residents of the area,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska supports the request for an appropriation of \$75,000 from the State of Alaska to the Bethel Family Clinic for the purchase of medical equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's representative in accepting and implementing the grant award.
