Ordinance #06-03

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 9.24.010 C OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE, AND ENACTING A REPLACEMENT SECTION 9.24.010 C, D AND E REGARDING CONCEALED HANDGUNS

WHEREAS the State of Alaska has amended AS 29.35.145 relating to regulation of firearms; and

WHEREAS the City of Bethel has a contrary statute which applies to regulation of firearms; and

WHEREAS the City seeks to conform with Alaska State Statutes, and therefore, this amendment is necessary;

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a permanent nature and shall replace Bethel Municipal Code 9.24.010 C.

SECTION 2. Repeal of Bethel Municipal Code Section 9.24.010 C. The Bethel Municipal Code section 9.24.010 C existing on the date of this ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Enactment of Revised Bethel Municipal Code Section 9.24.010 C and the addition of Section D and E. The following is adopted as Bethel Municipal Code Section 9.24.010 C, D, and E:

C. Carry a firearm, air rifle or a deadly weapon in any restricted access area of municipal government buildings.

D. All restricted access areas of municipal government buildings shall have posted the prohibition against possession of firearms at each entrance to the restricted access area.


E. For purposes of this ordinance:

"Firearms" includes firearms, or any other element relating to firearms or parts thereof including ammunition and reloading components.

"Restricted access area" means the area beyond a secure point where visitors are screened and does not include common areas of ingress and egress open to the general public.
