### **Resolution #05-02**

#### **A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF AN FY05 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT APPLICATION TO BENEFIT THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND THOSE THEY SERVE**

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Office of Domestic Preparedness, has awarded the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management \$14,879,381 for the FY2005 Homeland Security Grant Program;

**WHEREAS**, Homeland Security grant applications for Fiscal Year 2005 will be accepted until March 3, 2005 for a performance period of March 28, 2005 through March 31, 2007;

**WHEREAS**, there is no limit to the amount of money that can be requested in the 2005 Homeland Security Grant application and no cash or in-kind match is required;

**Whereas**, the preparation of the grant application will be a collaborative effort among Bethel agencies in a position to benefit from a Homeland Security Grant award, including the Bethel Police, Fire, and Public Works departments, Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Corporation, Bethel Search and Rescue, and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health;


