A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE TRANSFER OF THE DOCK AREA OF THE PORT OF BETHEL FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO THE CITY OF BETHEL FOR REASONABLE CONSIDERATION FROM THE STATE

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska is desirous to transfer the dock and uplands to the City of Bethel;

WHEREAS, a significant amount of money is needed to provide the proper maintenance and upkeep for the dock and the surrounding uplands;

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has offered to make this transfer for an estimated receipt of \$2,500,000 plus a current budgeted amount of \$632,000 for a total of approximately \$3,100,000;


WHEREAS, this amount of revenue would enhance the feasibility of the transfer of the dock property to the City; help in the needed maintenance and improvements to the property necessary for the operation of the port;


WHEREAS, the Bethel Port Commission has considered this matter and has recommended that the City Council accept the offer made by the State of Alaska to transfer the City dock to the City of Bethel;

WHEREAS, Resolution 02-14 was passed unanimously in 2002 in support of the City of Bethel acquiring ownership of the municipal dock in regards to Senate Bill No. 111.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of Bethel hereby supports the proposed offer to transfer the City dock area and surrounding uplands from the State of Alaska to the City of Bethel for the estimated amount of \$3,100,000 that has been proposed by the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.
