WHEREAS, local hire increases the employment skills of the local workforce and allows the City to participate in on-the-job training programs, and;


WHEREAS, preferential hiring will be extended only to those apprentices that meet the requirements and qualifications of the open position, and;


WHEREAS, local hire benefits the community as a whole,
