Minutes of Council meeting of May 21, 1962 at the National Guard Armory.

Present: Hoffman, Gibson, Miyasato, Schrimmer, Shantz and Gamble.

Meeting called to order.

Minutes of the April 2nd meeting were read and approved as read.

Correspondence was read.

The Secretary is to write to the Fairbanks Insurance Agency to find out if the rate quoted for insurance for the fireman is per man or for the group for the year. Also a letter is to be written to the lawyer asking his advice on this matter.

MMS Shantz/Gamble to order 100 rabies shots, stating that more may be needed at a later date, and also to find out the length of time this protection is good for. Hoffman, Miyasato, Gibson, Gamble and Shantz in favor.

MMS Gibson/Hoffman To write a reply to Mr. Pounders on his request to rent the building on 3rd and Main, stating due to our plans for the building we do not feel we can rent it at this time. MC

The secretary is requested to write to the Secretary of State inquiring into housebill 122 and how it may affect the city of Bethel, also requesting a copy of this bill as passed.

MMS Shantz/Hoffman to pay bill presented by Edward Hoffman for dozing the dump, in the amount of \$210.00. Hoffman, Miyasato, Gibson, Gamble and shantz in favor

MMS Shantz/Hoffmanto accept Resolution No. 12, concerning fines as read. Hoffman, Miyasato, Gibson, Gamble and Shantz in favor.

MMS Gibson/Gamble to authorize an amount not to exceed \$500.00 to haul such sand as needed to cover garbage dump with a roadway through center, and to cover the approach to the septic pond. Also that a shoot arrangement to carry the waste to the center of the septic pond be constructed. Hoffman, Miyasato, Gamble, Gibson and Shantz in favor.

MMS Shantz/Gibson to pay bills in the amount of \$320.89 for repairs on the city jeep and for mounting tank on fire trunk. Hoffman, Miyasato, Gamble, Gibson and Shantz in favor.

MMS Gamble/Shantz to pay bill in the amount of \$177.00 for painting fire truck. Hoffman, Miyasato, Gibson, Gamble, Shantz in favor.

MMS Gibson/Hoffman to extend a vote of thanks to Doug Vollertson, Mr. A. Schmidt and Don Shantz for the fine job they have done in setting up a fire department. Motion Carried

MMS Shantz/Hoffman to extend meeting as necessary. Motion Carried

The Deep Sea Port of the Kuskokwim

MMS Shantz/Gamble that write to Captain Elmore to extend our thanks to him for bringing the fire truck out. Motion carried.

MMS Gamble/Gibson to pay the City Clerk during the month she was on vacation. Hoffman/Miyasato/Gibson/ Gamble and Shantz in favor.

MMS Gamble/Gibson that the City pays the employers share of FICA and AUI on jail guards hired for the State. Hoffman/Miyasato, Gibson, Gamble and Shantz in favor.

MMS Gibson/Gamble to accept the police Report as read. Motion Carried.

A letter is to be written to Larry Paquette stating that he will be given two months to get to Sanitation truck in operating order, as it was received by him, and as agreed upon in the lease.

Hoffman recommends that Miyasato obtain an estimate on how much it would cost to fix the building on 3rd and Main, so that it could be used to store the sanitation truck in. A report to be made at the next meeting.

MMS Hoffman/Gibson to have the lawer draw up bid forms for ^{MINOR} repairs and maintance on City vehicles. Bids to be let on one year basis, with all work guaranteed. Bids to be based upon hourly labor costs and parts replacements. Motion Carried.

MMS Gamble/Hoffman to secure a radio and antenna for police car. Hoffman, Miyasato, Gibson, Gamble and Shantz in favor.

MMS Shantz/Hoffman that Darrel Connick be contacted as a replacement as the City policeman, and that we look into the possibilities of sending him to the traing school operated by the State Police. Motion Carried.

MMS Shantz/Gibson that we accept the offer made by Samuelson Flying Service as presented for spraying for mosquitos. Hoffman, Miyasato, Gibson, Gamble, and Shantz in favor.

MMS Gibson/Shantz that we accept the lower bid of the two bids submitted for oil delivery, which was submitted by Hoffman Fuel Service. Hoffman Miyasto, Gibson, Gamble and Shantz in favor.

Gibson/Shants that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
