## Special Meeting

Minutes of the City Council Meeting  
January 21, 1962

At the National Guard Armory

Present: Gamble, Weise, Eddie Hoffman, Shantz, Swanson

As this was not a regular council meeting the reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

MMS Schantz/Gamble to have the contract with the Alaska State Police amended to read to have the term of the State Trooper be for a period of three years, that we will pay for the moving of household goods one way only, that we pay actual cost of moving household goods in an amount not to exceed \$875.00. That the City may buy the car back at the end of three years for \$1.00. That the car should be written into the contract, showing amortization, then written off again showing that we will not pay this amount. The equipment bought to meet State Specifications but remain in the name of the City. Gamble, Shantz, Hoffman and Weise in favor.

MMS Shantz/E. Hoffman to have Eddie Hoffman hire someone to shoot dogs at \$2.00 per head, and hire a truck for one day not to exceed \$20.00, the total not to exceed \$100.00. two days notice is to be given, dogs are to be shot on Monday January 28th. Gamble Shantz, Hoffman and Weise in favor.

The living on the right away of the road, and empty buildings that are left open was discussed but no decision was reached.

Recommendations from the Council to Rep. Ray Christiansen was discussed feeling being that roads, and Rivers and Harbors should be pushed.

MMS Gamble/Weise meeting be adjourned. MO
