A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF BETHEL PROTESTING THE ISSUANCE OF A STATE OF ALASKA ALCOHOLIC RESTAURANT EATING PLACE LICENCE FOR CORINA'S RESTAURANT; LOCATED AT 238 EAST AVE. SLOUGH; OWNED BY KILSUH PARK; LICENSE ID# - 4955

WHEREAS, based on the advisory votes cast at the January 19, 2010 City of Bethel, Special Election the citizens of Bethel voted in opposition to the issuance of all types of alcohol licensing within the City of Bethel;

WHEREAS, the location does not have adequate ingress to and egress from the premises;

WHEREAS, the premises has no dedicated parking for patrons which could provide concern for traffic and officer safety and violates the BMC;

WHEREAS, the area surrounding the facility experiences an unacceptable rate of alcohol abuse or crime or accidents in which alcohol is involved as a cause;

WHEREAS, less than six tables is available for pubic seating which by State of Alaska guidelines they do not have enough occupancy for a license;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Bethel City Council for the reasons set forth above, the City of Bethel does hereby protest the application for the above identified restaurant eating place liquor license and requires the City Clerk to send this resolution to the Alcohol Beverage Control Board before February 8, 2010.

ENACTED THIS 26 DAY OF JANUARY 2010 BY A VOTE OF 6 IN FAVOR AND 0 OPPOSED.
