A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE ADOPTED ANNUAL FY 2001-2002 BUDGET

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL THAT THE FY 2001-02 Annual Budget be amended as follows:


