## RESOLUTION #96-44

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL TO APPLY FOR A RURAL CAP ALASKA EPA AMERICORPS MEMBER POSITION TO ENHANCE RECYCLING AND WASTE MANAGEMENT EFFORTS IN THE COMMUNITY OF BETHEL.**

WHEREAS, the Alaska EPA AmeriCorps Program recruits and trains individuals to serve for one year in their own community to improve solid waste management and sanitation; and

WHEREAS, the Bethel Recycling Project is the leading agency in the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta addressing resource reclamation, re-use, and recycling; and

WHEREAS, a position with AmeriCorps will help the Bethel Recycling Project to establish efficient networking between Delta communities, and to continue developing interest in better solid waste management, while minimizing pollution for the Yup'ik Native Alaskans who depend on a pollution-free environment for their subsistence lifestyles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska hereby applies to become an Alaska EPA AmeriCorps Program Site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council endorses the application of Brian Glasheen, Director of the Bethel Recycling Project, to be an Alaska EPA AmeriCorps Member
