CITY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:

John Snodgrass reported the following:

1. That Mr. O'Neill, representative for the General Telephone Co. is in town and is repairing the system.
2. The Siren is mounted but we are still waiting for parts.
3. The Cowan Hut repairs are completed.
4. The Commissioner has stated verbally that the State is not interested in re-negotiating the State Trooper's contract at this time.
5. The City received a call from the Director of the Campfire Girls re their Summer Program.
6. Vehicle Maintenance Contract for the City should be re-negotiated.
7. Requests for two Gaming Permits have been received.

NEW BUSINESS:

S-NOBILE REGULATIONS:

Bruce Crow distributed a written outline to the Councilmen and the citizens attending the meeting. Bruce Crow suggested that Joseph Pike chair the committee to outline needed regulations. Councilman Pike agreed to chair the committee and requested that Rae Baxter, Rex Root and John Malone assist him. The three gentlemen agreed to serve on the Committee. Bruce Crow then suggested that the Committee present a skeleton outline of needed sno-mobile regulations to the Village Chief's at their meeting in Bethel, January, 15 and 16.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor Nicholson asked that the question of rates for the Prematernal Home be placed on the Agenda under Old Business:

Motion made by Melvin Klokow and seconded by David Swanson "That this item of business be placed on the Agenda." Carried unanimously with 6 ayes.

Motion made by Bruce Crow and seconded by Al Laroux "That a minimum rate of \$1.50 per day be established for room and board at the Prematernal Home." Motion carried unanimously with 6 ayes.

Motion made by David Swanson and seconded by Joseph Pike "That the question of the Contract for vehicle maintenance be placed on the agenda" Carried unanimously with 6 ayes.

Motion made by David Swanson and seconded by Joseph Pike "That the contract for the maintenance of the City Vehicles be put out for bid. Carried unanimously with 6 ayes.

Motion made by David Swanson and seconded by Al Laroux that the question of gaming licenses for the V.F.W. and The Kuskokwim Valley Assoc. be placed on the Agenda." Carried with 5 ayes and one abstension.

Motion made by Joseph Pike and seconded by Al Laroux "That both of the requests for Gaming Permits be approved by the Council" Carried with 5 ayes with one abstension.

Letter from the Alaska Legal Services Corp...was re-read by David Swanson. Arthur Nicholson read his proposed reply to the letter. Bruce Crow also read his proposed reply to the letter. General discussion ensued. Motion made by Bruce Crow and seconded by Al Laroux "That Council make a formal reply to the letter that was written to Council from Mr. Jacobs, Director of the Alaska Legal Services Corporation." Carried unanimously with 6 ayes.

Motion made by Arthur Nicholson and seconded by David Swanson "That a Committee consisting of John Snodgrass, Melvin Klokow, Bruce Crow and Arthur Nicholson meet at the City Office at 1:00 P.M. Tuesday, January 9th to formulate a letter of reply to the Alaska Legal Services Corporation!" Carried with 6 ayes.

Motion made by Bruce Crow and 2nd by Joseph Pike that the meeting be adjourned Carried unanimously.
