

ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN AMMENDMENT TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 30 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2, LISTING A CERTAIN OFFENSE AND MISDEMEANOR AS UNLAWFUL IN THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION, AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA

It shall be unlawful for any person in the City of Bethel, Alaska

to:

(30) Drive, or own a track vehicle which is driven on the roads of Bethel, unless the driver and/or owner leaves the roads traveled upon in essentially the same condition as the same roads were previous to the driver's and/or owner's traveling upon them.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof by the City Magistrate, be fined in any sum not to exceed ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00), or be imprisoned in the city jail for a period not to exceed THIRTY (30) DAYS, or both such fine and imprisonment.

This amendment to Ordinance No. 2 shall become effective the day following its final passage and approval.
