OLD BUSINESS:

POLICE CONTRACT:

Chairman Joseph Pike reported committees recommendations re Police Contract That the State Police Contract be approved by the Bethel City Council. General discussion ensued.

Motion made by David Swanson and seconded by Joseph Pike "That the City of Bethel invite Mr. May, Director of Youth and Adult Authority, and Mr. Personnett, Commissioner of Public Safety to Bethel to discuss the Police question. Motion passed unanimously with five ayes.

Motion made by Bruce Crow and seconded by Al Laroux "That the City advise the Department of Public Safety that we will accept the July 68/ June 69 State Trooper Contract contingent upon a successful negotiation of the Jail problem." Passed unanimously with 5 ayes.

COMMUNITY CENTER DRAWINGS:

David Swanson offered report of his Committee recommending that the State Department of Bldgs. will draw up the preliminary architectural drawing for the proposed Community Building - costree. Committee suggested further that the City request that the piling plans be offered as soon as possible in the hope that the piling can be shipped via first boat and set this winter. Motion made by David Swanson and seconded by Joseph Pike "That the City of Bethel write a letter to the Governor requesting the architectural services of the Division of Buildings. Motion passed unanimously with 5 ayes.

CITY POLICEMANS PAY:

Motion made by Bruce Crow and seconded by Joseph Pike "That the City police pay in question be paid and that the City Administrator advise him that his tour of duty would be Sunday thru Thursday 9:00 P.M. to 12:00 P.M. and that the Police Committee have an executive meeting after the next regular council meeting to discuss this question further. Poll Vote - unanimous with 5 ayes.

CITY CLERK POSITION

Motion made by David Swanson and seconded by Bruce Crow "That the City Council retain the services of Jack Baxter, at 150.00 per month to keep the City Controls, submit monthly financial statements, and do the Quarterly Reports. Poll Vote: Unanimous with 5 ayes.

Motion made by David Swanson and seconded by Al Laroux "That the City of Bethel post notice of City Clerk Position at \$500.00 monthly." Motion passed unanimously with 5 ayes.
