

Minutes of City Council Meeting
December 2, 1963

At the National Guard Armory
8:00 P.M.

Present: Swanson, Baker, Hoffman, Sallison, Schirmer, Mendola & Weise

The new council members, Donald Baker, Joe Sallison, Don Schirmer and Joe Mendola, were sworn in by repeating the oath of office in response to the mayor.

The minutes of the November 4th meeting were read and approved as read.

Miscellaneous correspondence was read and reports were given by the Police and Sanitation committees.

MMS/Mendola, Schirmer that the Volunteer Fire Dept. be reimbursed in the amount of \$208.33. Baker, Hoffman, Sallison, Schirmer, Mendola and Weise in favor. MC.

MMS/Weise, Schirmer that it be posted that the city has taken over Accounts Receivable and Accounts Payable of the Baker Sanitation Service up to Aug. 15th, 1963 which was terminated at this date. Any accounts contracted by Donald Baker Sanitation Service up through Aug. 15, 1963 must be presented to the city council within 20 days of this posting. This account will be considered closed as of December 31, 1963. MC.

Sanitation Service truck report given by Ben Wilkens. Discussion ensued. Schirmer nominated Academy Blue as the color for the truck. MC by a vote of five ayes and one nay.

MMS/Hoffman, Schirmer that the sanitation truck be purchased per attached specifications to cost not more than \$5,460.00 f.o.b. Seattle plus freight charges to Anchorage less excise Bethel tax on truck alone. Hoffman, Schirmer, Weise, Baker, Sallison, Mendola in favor.. MC.

MMS/Weise, Mendola that the sanitation tank in the amount of \$1810.00 be paid within 30 days after acceptance. \$500.00 down on Sanitation truck, \$1,000.00 to be paid within 10 days after acceptance and balance to be paid on truck within 90 days after acceptance with all monies to be taken out of general fund. Hoffman, Schirmer, Weise, Baker, Sallison and Mendola in favor. MC.

MMS/Schirmer, Mendola that the meeting be continued. MC.

MMS/Schirmer, Weise that Fensguard be sent a letter requesting payment within 30 days of the tax accrued through September 1963 or legal action will be taken. (Copy of ordinance showing foreclosure procedure to be included in the letter.) MC.

There was a discussion about city sales tax being collected on long distance calls. It was ascertained that other cities do not charge a city sales tax on long distance calls.

MMS/Schirmer, Baker that a letter be written to advise Litto of Tundra Telephone that the city sales tax on long distance calls and telegrams be discontinued effective January 1, 1964. MC.

MMS/Schirmer, Mendola that the meeting be adjourned. MC.
