AMENDED RESOLUTION #93-34

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING CAPITAL PROJECTS/LEGISLATIVE REQUESTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1995 AND REQUESTING APPROPRIATE FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS FOR BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES PROJECTS, AND THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS FOR THE BANK STABILIZATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bethel has determined a need to provide the community with efficient City Government services and public safety; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to promote economic development through tourism and Port facilities development; and

WHEREAS, the following projects would provide community-wide benefit through improved public safety and City Government coordination, and an improved economic base from expanded Port functions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, that the following projects are identified as projects of community-wide benefit and are included in the list of Capital Improvement Projects/Legislative Requests for Fiscal Year 1995:

1.	Bethel Government and Public Safety Building	\$	6,000,000
2.	Braund Building Garage Renovation		500,000
3.	Port Offices and Visitor's Center		800,000
4.	Bethel Bank Stabilization Project (Seawall Matching Funds)		744,000
	Total Costs	\$	8,044,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby instructed to advise the Governor, Legislature and the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and Department of Community and Regional Affairs of the projects supported by the City Council for the Fiscal Year 1995 and to take all appropriate steps to provide the necessary background information.
