RESOLUTION #97-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING REQUESTS FROM THE GOVERNOR'S CAPITAL BUDGET AND LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES.

WHEREAS, The City Council of Bethel, Alaska has held a work session to discuss and establish priorities for funding requests and legislative matters, and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to formalize their requests for consideration by the Governor and legislature of the State of Alaska.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council establishes the following priorities for funding in the State budget:

1. Water and Sewer Improvement projects (completion of Phase I)
2. Power Cost Equalization maintenance
3. Funding for state leases in the Braund Building


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council establishes the following legislative concerns and priorities:

1. Bike and pedestrian trails
2. State collection of point-of-sale alcohol taxes, with a low percentage retained by the state as payment for the service.
3. Expansion and complete staffing of the Bethel District Attorney's office.
4. Local education facilities
5. The ability for a second class city to adopt a home rule charter.
