MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

June 17th, 1963

At the National Guard Armory

Minutes of the May 13th meeting were read and approved as read.

MMS Shantz/J. Hoffman to expend a figure not to exceed \$100.00 to make applications for Tidelands in front of the City of Bethel. Weise-nay Laroux Naye- In favor Shantz, E. Hoffman, J. Hoffman and Gamble.

MMS Shantz/E. Hoffman move we do not accept the contract with the State in regards to road and airport maintenance, at this time but for it to be taken under consideration for the fiscal year 1964-1965 and that the road committee work on getting a more concrete contract. MC

MMS Shantz/J. Hoffman That the bill presented by Albert Schmidt in the amount of \$265.00 be paid for trash haul ~~has paid~~ and that he be authorized to pick up the rest of the trash with the total amount of trash haul not to exceed \$300.00. MMS Shantz/Gamble to pay the bill in the amount of \$17.00 for blankets, Etc. hauled to airport at time of flood for the Civil Defense. Gamble, J. Hoffman Laroux, E. Hoffman Shantz, Weise in favor.

MMS Gamble/Shantz that the city clerk present a financial statement at each Council meeting. MC

MMS Gamble/Shantz that we appoint Mr. Nicholson to continue to negotiate for Herman Egoaks and John Nerby's lots on which to place the municipale building. MC

The road committee is to write to the highway engineers to express our appreciation for the help they gave us on the road program.

MMS Shantz/Gamble that E. Hoffman be authorized to dump one drum of stove oil onto the Sanitation dump. Weise, Shantz, E. Hoffman, Laroux, J. Hoffman and Gamble in favor.

MMS E. Hoffman/Laroux That we accept the Liquor Petition's commetter report as read. 5 ayes 1 nay. Motion carried. Report attached.

MMS Shantz/E. Hoffman to extend the meeting as necessary. MC

MMS Shantz/Gamble that the Chairman write to Thomas B. Stewart, Administration Director, Court System to find out more about acquireing a District Magistrate. MC
